Dr. Salman Al Jerdi is Assistant Professor of Neurology at Weill Cornell Medicine-Qatar (WCM-Q), and the director of the Neurology Clerkship. Dr. Al Jerdi is also a Vascular Neurologist at Hamad Medical Corporation.

After graduating from WCM-Q, Dr. Al Jerdi moved to United States to pursue his clinical training, completing his internship in Internal Medicine at New York Medical College's Westchester Medical Center in 2013, and his residency in Neurology at the University of Vermont Medical Center in 2016. Afterwards, he completed a Vascular Neurology fellowship at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

Throughout his time in the United States, Dr. Al Jerdi was heavily involved in medical student and resident education. During his Neurology residency, he was officially appointed as Instructor of Neurology at the University of Vermont's Lerner College of Medicine. He also co-developed the first formal Neurology Board Review course and first Introduction to Clinical Neurology course aimed at resident education. In 2015, he was the recipient of the Arnold P. Gold Foundation Humanism and Excellence in Teaching Award.

Dr. Al Jerdi was a sub-investigator on multiple clinical trials focused in particular on Cerebrovascular Disease. Examples of these trials include NAVIGATE ESUS, POINT, DEFUSE III, SHiNE, iDEF, and others. Currently, his research interest involves aspects of management of acute ischemic stroke, stroke recovery, and innovation in medical education. His professional interests involve disparities in healthcare and healthcare management.
