His scientific research has been published in prestigious journals such as the *New England Journal of Medicine*, *Science*, *Lancet journals*, *JAMA*, *Nature Medicine*, *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, *Hepatology*, *PLOS Medicine*, and *Clinical Infectious Diseases*.

Findings from his research have been key in formulating public health policy at the national, regional, and international levels and have received wide global coverage.
